

Renaissance bags OMR37m contract from health ministry

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MUSCAT: The Contract Services arm of Renaissance Services was awarded an OMR37 million contract to provide catering, cleaning, laundry and pest control services at 34 hospitals of the Ministry of Health. The contract is for three years and

will be operated by the firm's Oman unit, Tawoos Industrial Services Co. The company previously operated almost 65 per cent of the services for MoH, and this new award will push that figure to over 85 per cent of the tendered work. "We have been providing patient care catering and related services ever since our

company was formed 28 years ago. We plan to use this significant contract award with the MoH to drive our in-country value programmes for Omani employment, local goods and services and SME development," said Ananda Fernando, CEO of the Renaissance Contract Services Group.
