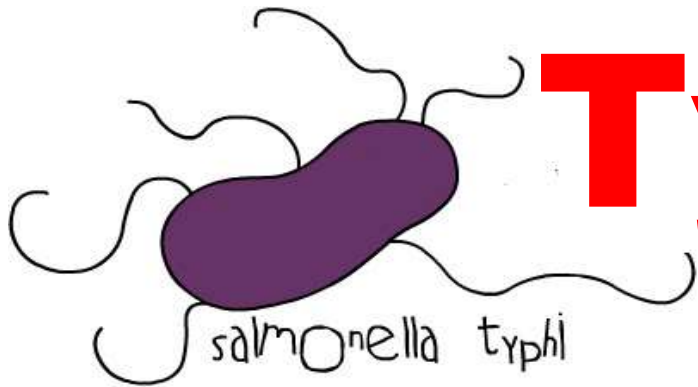


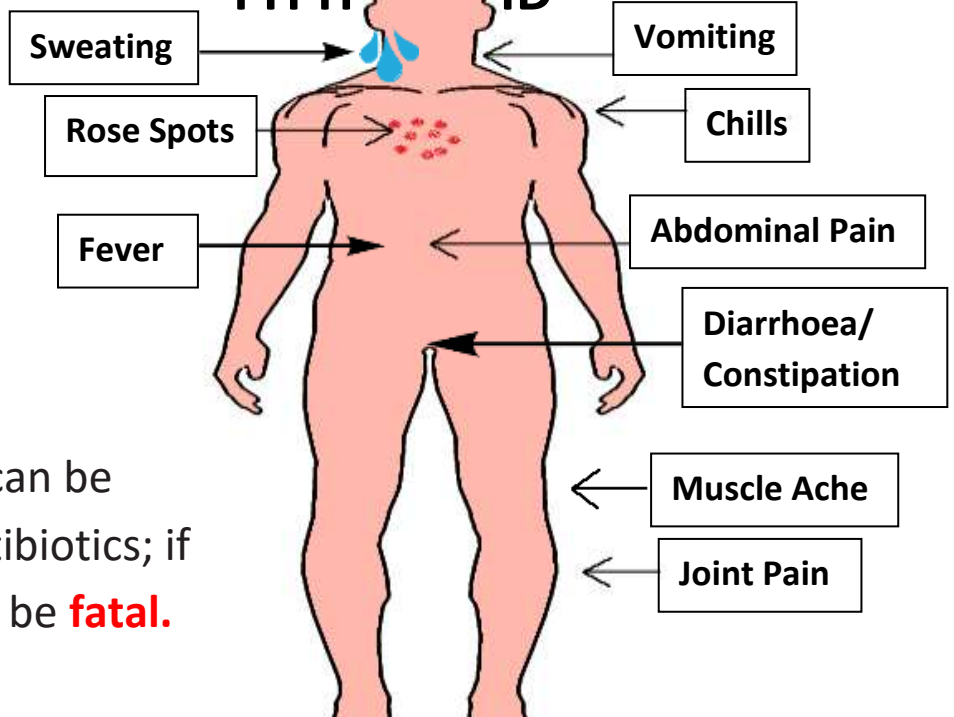

TYPH ID



Typhoid is a bacterial infection that can lead to a high fever diarrhoea, and vomiting.

It's caused by the bacteria *Salmonella typhi*.

If typhoid is caught early, it can be successfully treated with antibiotics; if it is not treated, typhoid can be **fatal**.

HOW TYPHOID SPREADS

The following are ways in which typhoid spreads:

- Contaminated food or water supply, especially after floods or natural disasters.
- Food outlets that practice poor food hygiene.
- Eating seafood from water sources that has been contaminated by faeces or urine.
- Using toilets contaminated by bacteria and not washing your hands
- Eating raw vegetables that have been fertilised by human faeces.
- Contaminated milk products.
