A hazard is defined as anything that has a potential to cause harm to people or assets.

Kitchens often have numerous slip, trip, and fall risks created by human error, or otherwise, meaning you and others need to focus closely on proper safety practices and housekeeping.



### Kitchen Risks:

- Falls & Trips
- Burns
- Cuts
- Strains
- Electrical Shocks
- Poisoning
- Choking



*Slip, trip, and fall hazards include:*

- Spillages of liquid on floor such as water, sauces, oil, and flour
- Wet floors from cleaning
- Obstructions in walkways, including trailing cables, boxes and crates, bins, cleaning equipment, etc
- Using a ladder to access high places
- Cleaning kitchen equipment such as hoods in high places
